## **Concord School District Policy #122**

## Treasurer

The Treasurer shall have the care and custody of all funds of the district and shall have and exercise under the supervision of the Board of Education all the powers and duties required by statute and commonly incident to his/her office. He/she shall keep or cause to be kept accurate books of account of all Concord School District transactions, which books shall be the property of the district and together with all other of its property in his/her possession shall be subject at all times to the inspection and control of the Board of Education. He/she shall deposit or cause to be deposited all funds of the district in such solvent bank or banks as the Board of Education may from time to time designate. The Treasurer shall give bond for the faithful performance and discharge of his/her duties in such amounts and with sureties as the Board of Education may from time to time determine.
