

Concord School District Policy #541.2
Dress Code

If a particular style of dress or personal grooming demonstrates that it would be disruptive to the educational process, constitutes a threat to the safety and health of the individual or others, or is in violation of any lawful statute, they would not be permitted in school. Within these limits, the final decision as to attire and grooming shall be the good judgment and responsibility of the individual and his/her parents.

The school staff will encourage all students to dress in a fashion that, in the staff's judgment, reflects good taste and appropriate for a school setting. However, if a student wishes to dress in a more individual fashion that still falls within the broad limits stated above and his/her parents agree, we would not deprive him/her the opportunity to attend school.
